


Students: After reading "Connections," fill in the four-step stages of metamorphosis for the three animals in the flow map below. Answer the questions at the end.



What is the life cycle?


Some animals go through a three-stage metamorphosis. What is this and what are some animals that develop this way?



Some insects have a three-stage egg-nymph-adult life cycle rather than four. Examples include cockroaches, butterflies and grasshoppers.




